DAY 5: INNSBRUCK - HOHENSCHWANGAU -OBERAMMERGAU - INNSBRUCK

Following breakfast, we enjoy an excursion to visit the world-renowned Neuschwanstein **Castle**. When thinking of Germany, one can't help but think of this castle, the most photographed location in the world and the inspiration for Cinderella's Castle in Disney World. We continue to **Oberammergau**, to explore this quaint alpine village and home of the famous Passion Play performed every ten years since 1634. Later this afternoon, we return to Innsbruck and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure with dinner under our own arrangements.

DAY 6: INNSBRUCK - MUNICH

As the Nazi's first concentration camp, originally designed for the detention of German political opponents of the Nazi regime, the camp was soon flooded by tens of thousands of deportees. We return to Munich later this afternoon with the option to participate in one of the two offered optional excursions or enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure. One option would be to embark on a guided tour of Nymphenburg Palace or a visit to the Bavarian State Opera. We have dinner under our own arrangements this evening.
