## Business Expense Receipts – Required Documentation

WAKE FOREST

When paying with University funds, regardless of the transaction type, all receipts must include:

- Transaction date
- Merchant/Supplier name
- Detail of items purchased or services provided
- Form of payment used (e.g., cash, check or credit card)
- Amount
- Proof of Payment

When paying with University funds, the following expenses all require **original**, **detailed receipts** to be provided when submitting invoices, reimbursement requests, and Pcard statements:

- Entertainment (non-meals)
- Local Meals
- Meals while in travel status exceeding \$50
- Books, periodicals and subscriptions
- Professional dues
- Office supplies
- Copy and printing services
- Telephone
- Other
