Dr. Raper and Dr. Champion then gave an update on Mental Health Care, Outreach and Prevention. There were some disquieting statistics regarding mental health on campus such as depression and self harm trends were somewhat higher for WFU than the national averages.

Dr. Penny Rue briefed the committee regarding the video that had recently gone viral and reported that the student who made the racist commit to an RA was no longer enrolled at Wake.
