Passport Information for Studying Abroad

As you discuss your student's study abroad plans, it is important that you check their passport's expiration date well in advance of their departure. Many countries require your student to have a visa before entering the country for their time abroad. A visa is official permission to enter a country and stay for a determined period of time. The visa stamp for a given country will be placed in your student's actual passport. This means they will need to physically send it to the host country's consulate. Because of this, your student must have a valid passport in order to apply for a visa.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Until your student has received their visa, it is highly advised to refrain from making international travel plans in the months preceding their study abroad semester.

If your student does not already have a passport, they should apply for one sooner rather than later. You and your student can view more information about passports and visa on our "Before You Go" page. You and your student should also refer to the U.S. Department of State's passport website about the application process. The Center for Global Programs and Studies can help guide your student through the application process.

If your student does have a passport, they should confirm its expiration date. Their passport must be valid for at least six months beyond the end-date of their study abroad program. Refer to the chart below for guidance on whether or not your student will need to apply for a new passport. If their passport will have less than six months remaining after the end-date of the program, or will expire while they are abroad, they should apply now for a replacement passport from the <u>U.S. Department of State</u>.

Summer 2025	Mid-February, 2026
Fall 2025	Late June, 2026
Spring 2026	Late November, 2026
Summer 2026	Mid-February, 2027
Fall 2026	Late June, 2027
Spring 2027	Late November, 2027
Summer 2027	Mid-February, 2028
