### **Friday Parking & Shuttles:**

Check out the [Campus Maps](#) before you arrive. **Weather permitting parking is available on Davis Field.** (Davis Field is across the street from the library, Reynolda Hall and the Benson Center), Lot B and Lot A. **In addition to these locations**, you may also park on campus wherever you find a parking space. If it has been raining Davis Field parking will not be allowed and you should take the shuttle. There are a limited number of handicapped spaces in each parking lot but probably on 4 or 5 in the small lot in front of Benson.

### **Shuttles: (Definitely use in case of rain)**

On Friday, we will be offering complimentary shuttles from **Lot Z3** (off Long Street) near the Polo Road Entrance to campus across from Winston Salem First Church from 9 a.m. – 1:00 a.m. Look for the shuttle stop sign. Additional on-campus parking will be available on a first come basis in Faculty/Staff lots Friday evening and Saturday for Festival on the Quad.

### **Campus Shuttle Stops: Friday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. will be in front of Benson in Lot C**

Uber and Lyft are available in Winston Salem along with cab and private transportation companies if you need transportation to and from the campus.
