HOLY SCRIPTURE READINGS

Psalms 90: The Psalms are a collection of sacred songs and poems prayed by both Christians and Jews around the world. Psalm 90 is one of the most well-known psalms of the Old Testament, and it is often read at funerals, because it speaks poignantly of the limits of our mortal lives and of the timeless dimension of God's power and love.

The Mourner's Kaddish: Written in Aramaic, the Mourner's Kaddish is an almost 2,000-year-old prayer, traditionally recited in memory of the dead. The prayer never mentions death or dying, but instead proclaims the greatness of God. By reciting it, mourners show that even as their faith is being tested by their loss, they are affirming God's greatness.

Surah Fatiha: The Qur'an is the holiest scripture for Muslims, and is understood to be the Word of God delivered to the Prophet Muhammad. It provides Muslims with ethical and spiritual guidance on how to live our lives in the best manner possible. Surah al-Fatiha is the first chapter of the Qur'an and is recited during each cycle of Muslim's five daily prayers. al-Fatiha, which means The Opening, is also often recited during funerals and visitation of graves. In this it acts as a supplication to God, that just as we wish to be kept on the straight path and be those who are close to God; so too do we wish this for our loved ones who have since passed.

Bhagavad Gita: The Bhagavad Gita is one of the most, if not the most, important Hindu sacred texts and is often referred to as the Hindu Bible. It covers a wide range of topics ranging from the nature of the soul to different spiritual disciplines that one can follow to come closer to divinity. The Gita has 18 chapters, and in the second chapter, there is a description of the soul. Verses 12, 13, and 20 of Chapter 2, which are often recited at funerals, remind us that the soul is eternal and will continue to live on after one passes away from this world. These verses provide comfort and solace for those who are mourning or grieving the loss of a loved one, assuring us that our loved ones are still out there somewhere and that we may have the chance to reunite with them.

This service is designed for those who are grieving, who want to remember those who have died. You are welcome in this place to listen, think, pray, sit, read, cry, remember, name, be present. Please stay as long as you want; leave when you need to go.
