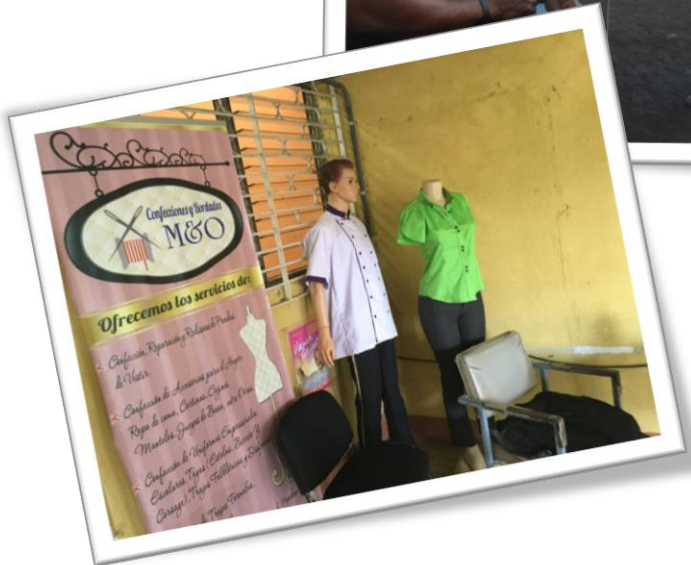
About Project Nicaragua

Conduct visits with the businesses who will attend our workshops



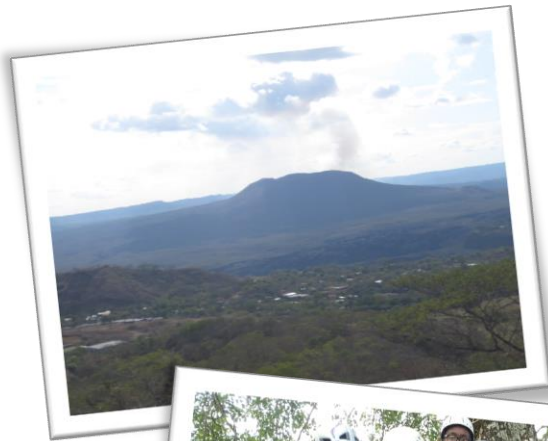
What We Do There

Student Learning Outcomes

Intercultural Inquiry	Students will be able to interpret events, values, and practices from multiple cultural perspectives.

Community Interaction	Students will be able to collaborate across diverse cultures and settings to address complex challenges.
Intercultural Communication	Students will be able to negotiate intercultural interactions using appropriate verbal and nonverbal communication skills.
Global Responsibility	Students will be able to formulate solutions to global challenges through informed decision-making and reflection.

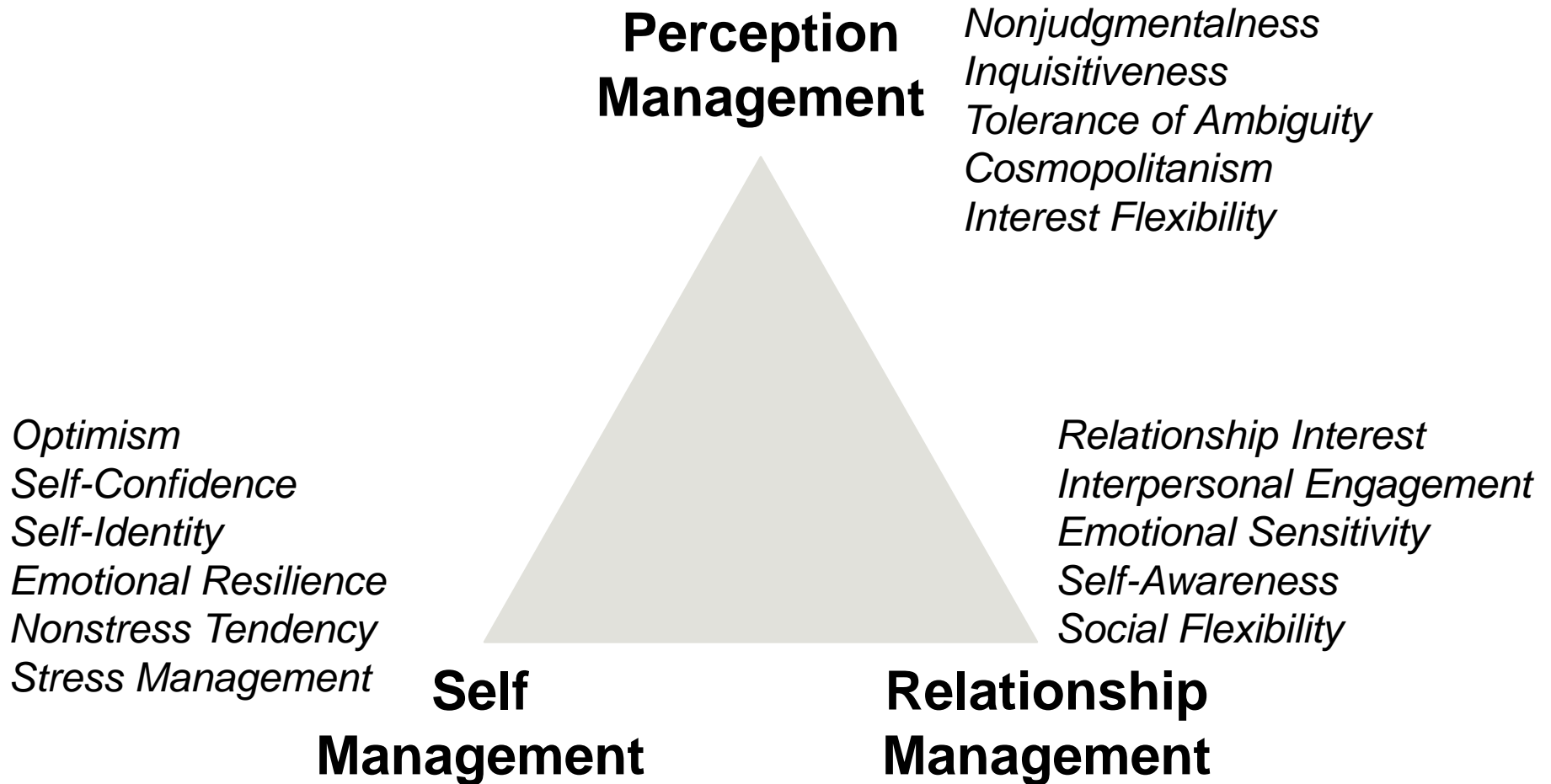

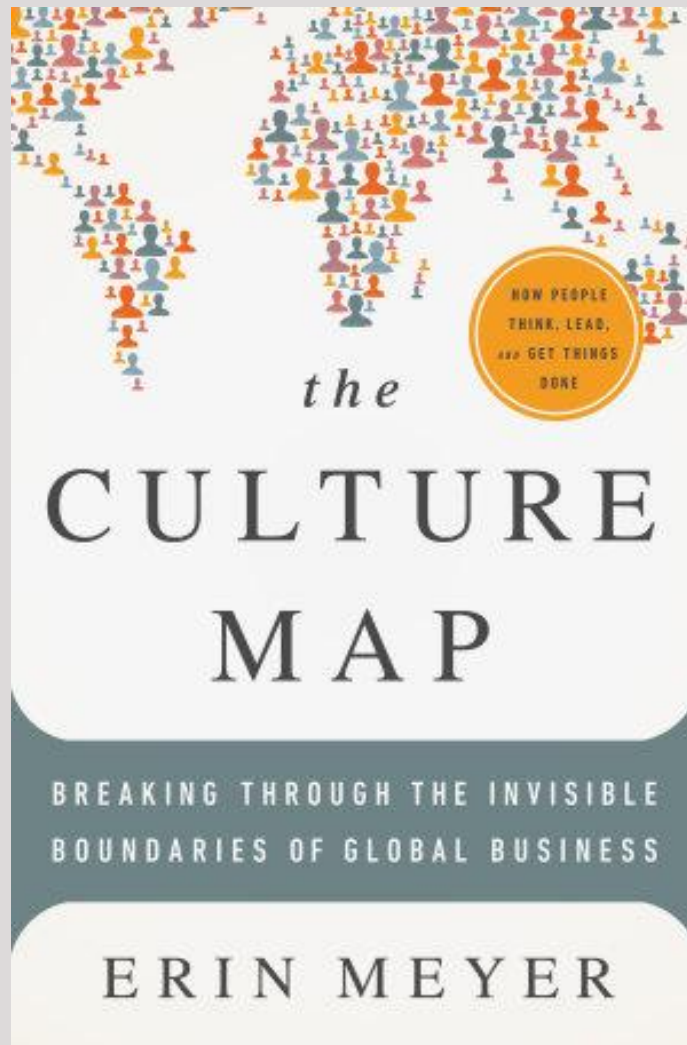
