Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs)

Self-Awareness

- Students will be able to explain how their own perspectives and experiences influence their understanding of other cultures.
- AAC&U Cultural Self-Awareness

Intercultural Inquiry

- Students will be able to interpret global events, values and practices from multiple cultural perspectives.
- AAC&U Intercultural Attitudes - Curiosity

Pre-test (August 15 - October 1) and Post-test (March 15 - May 1)

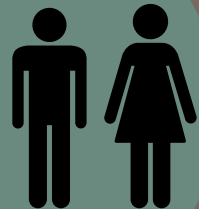
Students schedule 30-minute time slot with QEP Interview Team

Direct Assessment

- Participate in 20 minute interview, which includes sections for each SLO
- Responses are assigned a QEP rubric score for each SLO

Indirect Assessment

- 10 minute online questionnaire, completed in same session as qualitative interview



Participants

Initiative Participants

- Globally-interested students spending their first year abroad with Global AWAKEnings
- Pre-test sample size: 17
- Post-test sample size: Need 100% completion by participants

Control Group

- Globally-interested first-year students on Wake's campus who have expressed interest in going abroad.
- Pre-test sample size: ~30
- Post-test sample size: Need 75% completion by control

Coordinator role in assessment

- Helping to ensure 100% completion rate among initiative participants
- Collaborate with QEP Assessment team in identifying and communicating with control group participants
- Identifying and sharing additional ideas for assessment

Analyses

- Group differences between participants and control
- Pre- to post-test differences on SLOs
