Inmar Technology Scholarship

Instructions and Application

Inmar Technology Scholarships, begun in 2015, are awarded to up to five students who present solid academic credentials and who have a strong interest in Computer Science. Inmar Technology Scholarships, valued at \$10,000 annually, also allow students to earn money during the summers as an Intern. Inmar Technology Scholarships are renewable for eight semesters of undergraduate study. Expectations

Inmar Technology Scholars are required to enroll in a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester and to maintain an annual grade point average of at least 3.0 (out of a possible 4.0). Scholars must work for Inmar during summers of their freshman, sophomore and junior years. Spring and fall work studies with Inmar during their junior and senior years are optional, but not required. Scholars must declare a major in Computer Science or Information Technology by the start of the Junior Year. Scholars must make satisfactory progress toward the fulfillment of degree requirements each year. Scholars are required to maintain campus residency for all four years, excluding time spent studying abroad. The Office of the Dean of the College is consulted at the conclusion of each academic semester to ensure the Scholar has not violated any University regulations and is in good standing in regard to personal, honor code, and judicial conduct

Submitting the Application

The completed scholarship application must be submitted by February 15. Applicants also need to complete an application for Undergraduate Admissions to Wake Forest University.
