



Instructions for participating in the Novant Health Mobile Mammography Screening

You will need to register through the Professional Development Center website at: pdc.wfu.edu/events/2216/. Once you register, you will receive an email confirmation that will include action items and additional information.

The email will include three forms:

1. [Patient Information form](#)
2. [Patient Breast History form](#)
3. [Breast Center -Women's Risk Assessment](#)

You will need to print, complete, and submit the three forms to the Human Resources Office in a sealed envelope – by April 3. On the outside of the envelope please write - *Novant Health Mobile Mammography Screening*. The sealed envelope will be returned to Novant Health.

Please note, on the *Patient Information sheet* you **do not** need to list your social security number. On the top portion of the *Patient Breast History sheet* you only need to provide your name and date of birth. This information *will only* be reviewed by Novant Health professionals.

Eligibility:

- Must be 35 or over
- Must have a primary medical doctor (if you do not have a primary medical doctor, we can provide you with a list of agencies that offer a free mobile clinic and can be designated as your primary medical doctor).

Is the mammogram covered by insurance?

Mammograms are covered as preventive screening under most insurance plans. For your convenience, Novant Health will file a claim with your insurance provider on your behalf.

Wake Forest's BCBSNC medical plan provides coverage, at no charge, for one baseline mammogram for any female member between the ages of 35 and 39. Beginning at age 40, one screening mammogram will be covered per female member per calendar year.
