**Chemistry Assistantships** are valued at \$55,834 from which tuition is deducted. Each chemistry assistant will receive \$1,791.67 for twelve months. Stipend amount \$21,500.

**Religion Fellowships** are valued at \$38,354 from which tuition is deducted. Each fellow will receive \$420 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$4,200.

**Religion Assistantships** are valued at \$42,734 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$840 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$8,400.
