SUPPLEMENT A: EARLY DECISION OR EARLY DECISION II

Early Decision plans are for students who have selected Wake Forest as their first choice school and only active Early Decision application. Students applying Early Decision may submit an application at any time after completion of the junior year and no later than November 15. Decisions on these applications are made on a rolling basis. Early Decision II applications are due by January 1 and applicants are notified by February 15. Under both plans, students agree to enroll if admitted and to withdraw all applications from other institutions. A \$500 nonrefundable tuition deposit is due within 2 weeks of acceptance notification.
