SUPPLEMENT A: EARLY DECISION OR EARLY DECISION II

Students applying Early Decision must submit an application no later than November 15, and decisions are made on a rolling basis. Early Decision II applications are due by January 1 and applicants are notified by February 15. Under both plans, students agree to enroll if admitted and to withdraw all applications from other institutions. A \$1,500 nonrefundable tuition deposit is due within 2 weeks of acceptance notification.

Early Decision / Early Decision II

Early Decision (ED) plans are for students who have selected Wake Forest as their first-choice school and only active Early Decision application. If you are accepted under an Early Decision plan, you affirm the following:

- That I may make no additional applications to any other university in any country.
- That I must enroll at the institution to which I applied ED and for the term I applied.
- That I will send an enrollment deposit (or equivalent) to only that institution, as sending multiple deposits (or equivalent) may result in the withdrawal of my admission offers from all institutions.
- That my \$1,500 non-refundable tuition deposit is due within two weeks of admission.
