Did you know?

- Cybercrime costs are projected to reach \$2 trillion globally by the year 2019 in terms of direct damage and post-attack business disruption costs. [Forbes]
- Over 169 million personal records were exposed in 2015, stemming from breaches across the financial, business, education, government, and healthcare sectors. [ITRC]
- More than 317 million new pieces of malware were created last year, which means nearly one million threats were released each day. [CNN Money]
- The average time lapse between data breach and discovery is 200 days. Hackers sometimes have more than 6 months to compromise a system and search for valuable data. [ZDNet]

The IRS - with the Fort Knox of websites - was hacked in 2015. So was Experian. With the number of online security breaches increasing in epidemic proportions, the demand for expertise in cybersecurity is growing as well.
