Any student who wishes to park a vehicle on a university parking lot any time of day or night--including after 4:00 p.m. weekdays, on weekends, during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. weekdays, and during breaks-- must register that vehicle with Transportation and Parking Services.

First year student vehicle registration will begin Saturday, August 1, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. Go online at <u>http://parking.wfu.edu/</u> to register your vehicle. This website is also a great place to find information about parking during certain events like Thanksgiving, Winter Break or Spring Break.

Important note: In order to access the parking portal, you must specifically select your <u>WFU Google</u> account if you are logged into multiple accounts. For example, if you are only logged into your personal (non-WFU) Google Account then you will not be able to access the portal. *Either you need to only be logged into your WFU Google account or if you are logged into your personal Google Account, you will need to also log into your WFU Google Account and select that one from the list when prompted.*
