


Two-thirds of partner respondents have worked with PHI for more than three years.




One-third of partners represented focus on food security.




Two-thirds of responding partners have engaged with PHI through SNIP.




Four of five partner respondents typically engage with PHI through internships.




All respondents report increased or maintained capacity due to their organization's engagement with PHI.



More than 90 percent of respondents report no challenges associated with involvement with PHI programming.




Engagement with PHI has enhanced the economic impact of partners in several ways.




Partner respondents report a total of **\$200K** in economic impact, resulting from engagement with PHI.
