
FOUR CIRCLES OF DIVERSITY



Personality: we are typically born with these characteristics

Internal Dimensions: what people notice about us, many are visible, things we have little or no control over

External Dimensions: virtually invisible to others, we tend to have more control over these

<u>Organizational Dimensions</u>: can make a difference in how we see the world and how we act on a daily basis
