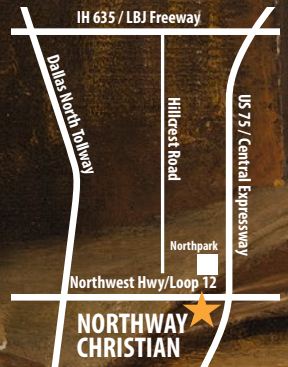

She is also an ELCA pastor, having served congregations in Detroit, Boston, and New York City in addition to old-fashioned circuit-riding in New England and North Carolina. Shaner is the author of *Enslaved Leadership in Early Christianity* (Oxford University Press, 2018), as well as several articles on Paul's letters. She also writes for *Working Preacher*.
