This application will collect some basic information about you and a description of your project. It is expected that the faculty mentor (s) will discuss the project and provide guidance on the application. Be sure that your project description includes the following:

1. Justification for your scholarly project (including Project Background, Rationale and Significance)
2. A detailed description of your Project Methods
3. Describe how this fellowship will benefit your educational and/or career plan

Reminder: *The Wake Forest Research Fellowship requires that students work full time on their projects. That is to say, students receiving this fellowship may not work outside the fellowship nor enroll in summer courses during the 10 consecutive weeks of the summer fellowship. Summer project dates should begin and end between May 17 - August 16, 2021.*

All equipment purchased for research must remain with the mentor as the department or lab's property, used as a resource for future research and/or study.

2021 Update: We anticipate awarding fellowships to undergraduate students for summer 2021. If there is a university update prohibiting on-campus housing during the summer, we will communicate with fellowship recipients accordingly.
