**Table 13. Graduate School Scholarships, Fellowships and Assistantships 2014-15**

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** Scholarships cover tuition for any size, but do not provide cash payment for either full-time or part-time students. Full-time Scholarship value is \$35,364. Part-time scholarship value is \$1,260 per hour.

**PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS:** Partial scholarships are offered to students who are enrolled full-time. Partial Scholarship value is \$29,710. Student responsible for \$5,654.

**PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS for 1<sup>st</sup> year Counseling students and Master Teacher Fellows:** Partial scholarships are offered to students who are enrolled full-time. Partial Scholarship value is \$28,612. Student responsible for \$6,752.

**DOCUMENTARY FILM PROGRAM:** Full-time tuition amount is \$35,364 during the academic year. Partial scholarships are offered to students who are enrolled full-time. For students entering 2014-15 the Partial Scholarship value is \$21,044. Student responsible for \$14,320 for the duration of their program.

**HEARST SCHOLARSHIP** is valued at \$5,000.

**INTERPRETING & TRANSLATION STUDIES PROGRAM:** Full-time tuition amount is \$35,364 during the academic year. **Certificate programs:** Part-time tuition amount is \$1,260 per hour.

**LIBERAL STUDIES PROGRAM:** Full-time tuition amount is \$35,364 during the academic year. Part-time tuition amount during the academic year is \$1,260 per hour. Summer 2014 tuition amount is \$800 per hour.

**MASTER TEACHER FELLOWSHIPS:** Fellows may be awarded a scholarship of \$9,600 during the summer and a full scholarship of \$35,364 during the academic year. Fellows will also receive \$6,426 disbursed in three equal installments at the beginning of the summer, fall, and spring semesters. Total award is \$51,390.

**SUMMER 2014 TUITION:** \$800 per hour.

**SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM:** Full-time tuition amount is \$35,364 during the academic year. Part-time tuition amount during the academic year is \$1,260 per hour.

**All Stipends are Taxable:**

**Master Teacher Assistantships:** Assistants may be awarded a scholarship of \$9,600 during the summer and a full scholarship of \$35,364 during the academic year. Assistants will receive \$535.50 per month for twelve months. Stipend Amount \$6,426. Total award is \$51,390.
