SCHOLARSHIPS: Scholarships cover tuition for any size, but do not provide cash payment for either full-time or part-time students. Full-time Scholarship value is \$36,420. Part-time scholarship value is \$1,300 per hour.

PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS: Partial scholarships are offered to students who are enrolled full-time. Partial Scholarship value is \$29,136. Student responsible for \$7,284.

DOCUMENTARY FILM PROGRAM: Full-time tuition amount is \$36,420 during the academic year. Partial scholarships are offered to students who are enrolled full-time. For students entering 2015-16 the Partial Scholarship value is \$22,100. Student responsible for \$14,320 for the duration of their program.

HEARST SCHOLARSHIP is valued at \$5,000.

MASTER TEACHER FELLOWSHIPS: Fellows may be awarded a scholarship of \$12,000 during the summer and a partial scholarship of \$29,136 during the academic year. Fellows will also receive \$6,626 disbursed in three equal installments at the beginning of the summer, fall, and spring semesters. Total award is \$47,762.

SUMMER 2015 TUITION: \$1,000 per hour.

All Stipends are Taxable:

Master Teacher Assistantships: Assistants may be awarded a scholarship of \$12,000 during the summer and a partial scholarship of \$29,136 during the academic year. Assistants will receive \$552.17 per month for twelve months. Stipend Amount \$6,626. Total award is \$47,762.

1st year Biology MS Assistantships are valued at \$54,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,516.67 per month for twelve months. Stipend amount \$18,200.

2nd year Biology MS Assistant are valued at \$51,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,520 per month for ten months (August – May). Stipend amount \$15,200.

Biology Doctoral Assistantships are valued at \$59,120 from which tuition is deducted. Each Biology Ph.D. assistant will receive \$1,891.67 per month for twelve months. Stipend amount \$22,700.

Chemistry Assistantships are valued at \$59,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each chemistry assistant will receive \$1,933.33 for twelve months. Stipend amount \$23,200.

Chemistry GlaxoSmithKline Assistantship is valued at \$61,620 from which tuition is deducted. Assistant will receive \$2,100 per month for twelve months. Stipend amount \$25,200.

Communication, Counseling, Documentary Film, English Assistantships are valued at \$45,188 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$876.80 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$8,768.

Computer Science Assistantships are valued at \$49,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,320 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$13,200.

English Fellowships are valued at \$40,904 from which tuition is deducted. Each fellow will receive \$448.40 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$4,484.

Health and Exercise Science Assistantships are valued at \$46,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,020 for 10 months. Stipend amount \$10,200.

Math Assistantships are valued at \$47,620 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,120 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$11,200.

Physics Assistantships are valued at \$58,120 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,808.33 per month for twelve months. Stipend amount \$21,700.

Physics Excellence Fellowships are valued at \$60,120 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,975 per month for twelve months. Stipend amount \$23,700.

Psychology Assistantships are valued at \$46,545 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$1,012.50 for 10 months. Stipend amount \$10,125.

Religion Assistantships are valued at \$45,020 from which tuition is deducted. Each assistant will receive \$860 per month for ten months. Stipend amount \$8,600.
