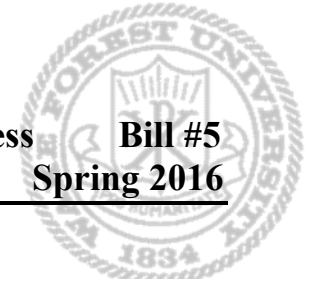

WHEREAS: Article III, Section II, Subsection c of the Student Government Constitution states that the Campus Life Committee is: "responsible for the improvement of the quality of life on campus in terms of student services and social concerns;" and

WHEREAS: the Campus Life Committee would also like to promote engagement and interactions between Wake Forest students and the broader Winston-Salem community; and

WHEREAS: the Bethesda Center Sleep Out will raise funds and needed supplies to help members of the Winston Salem community who are homeless and raise awareness for issues connected to homelessness and poverty in Forsyth County; and

WHEREAS: the Campus Life Committee is interested in promoting awareness for issues that intimately affect members of our community and has a commitment to building the relationship between Wake Forest students and members of the broader Winston Salem community; and

WHEREAS: the Campus Life Committee has met with organizers of the event and determined that Student Government is able to assist in marketing the initiative and providing support.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Campus Life Committee of Student Government recommends that Student Government co-sponsor the Bethesda Center Sleep Out initiative on November 12, 2016 to promote awareness for issues connected to homelessness in the Forsyth County area.
