**Enforcement of Policy 19 on the Guide to Community Living
Committee on Campus Life**

**Resolution #2
Fall 2016**

WHEREAS: The Campus Life Committee is responsible for the improvement of the quality of life on campus in terms of student services and social concerns; and

WHEREAS: The Wake Forest University Student Government recognizes the importance of creating a campus environment that promotes a freedom of speech and self-expression for all students; and

WHEREAS: The Wake Forest University Student Government has worked to foster and inclusive environment, and recent inequitable enforcement of the Campus Posting Policy found on page 50 of the Student Code of conduct has infringed on the free expression of identity for several students belonging to marginalized groups; and

WHEREAS: The Campus Posting Policy fails to protect the marginalized identities of students and is contradictory to the inclusive community that Student Government is working to build.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Wake Forest University Student Government condemns the inequitable enforcement of aforementioned Code of Conduct policy and strongly encourages the administration to continue moving forward with plans to review and revise said policy with input from students and faculty and we have the expectation that the University will deliberately implement the new policy equitably for all students.
