BILL

Be it Enacted by the Senate of the Wake Forest University Student Government here assembled,

SECTION 1. Article IV Section 4 of the Bylaws is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The voting record of each <u>Senator Member</u> on all measures and matters, excluding amendments on legislation brought to the floor and motions of parliamentary procedure, shall be recorded by the Secretary and <u>made available to the Co-Chairs of the Public Relations Committee made publicly available through the Wake Forest University Student Government website within one week after adjournment of the Senate meeting in which the vote occurs. <u>The Public Relations Committee shall have one week to publish the voting records after receiving them from the Secretary.</u> The voting records of all sessions shall be removed from that website every four years on May 30th or at the request of a graduating student. The removal of voting records shall be done by the incumbent <u>Secretary Co-Chairs of the Public Relations Committee of the Student Government."</u></u>

SECTION 2. This Bill shall take effect immediately.
