RESOLUTION

Whereas: The Wake Forest University Student Government Senate recently passed Senate Resolution No. 6: "Supporting Wake Forest's Jewish Community by Recognizing Anti-Semitism and Acts of Bigotry" and;

Whereas: The Student Government strives to represent the interest of our student body and act on issues which impact the wellbeing of our campus community, and;

Whereas: The purpose of Resolution No. 6 was to affirm the Student Government's support for Wake Forest Jewish students who faced a discriminatory incident on campus, and;

Whereas: The Student Government recognizes that we failed to properly consult student communities who were impacted by the language of Resolution No. 6, and;

Whereas: The Student Government wishes to clarify its position following Resolution No.6;

Therefore be it Resolved:

- 1.) The Wake Forest University Student Government does not take a position on the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, but rather condemns acts of hatred against a person based on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, genetic information, disability and veteran status;
- 2.) The Wake Forest University Student Government was not proposing changes to the University's Student Code of Conduct as it currently stands.
