BILL

Be it Enacted by the Senate of the Wake Forest University Student Government here assembled,

1 **SECTION I.** *Art. III, § 3 A(c)* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Constitution
2 shall be amended as follows:

3 “The Diversity and Inclusion Committee is responsible for intentionally and effectively
4 aiding in the process of creating and upholding a diverse and inclusive student body. This
5 diversity includes, but is not limited to, diversity of religion and spirituality, ethnicity and
6 race, gender and ~~sexuality~~ [sexual] orientation, socioeconomic status and residency
7 status, and/or thought and ideology, race, and gender. The Committee seeks to contribute
8 to discussions and actions [that] will address issues pertaining to the relevance of
9 inclusion of all Wake Forest undergraduate Students” and;

10 **SECTION II.** *Art. IX* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Constitution shall be
11 amended as follows:

12 “**Article IX [- Order of Interpretation]**”

13 **SECTION III.** *Art. XIV* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Bylaws shall be
14 amended as follows:

15 “**Article XIV. [Order of Interpretation]**”

16 **SECTION IV.** *Art. IV, § 4* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Bylaws shall be
17 amended as follows:

18 ~~“Section 4.~~ [Section 5.] “Members of Standing Committees may... for the entirety of the
19 meeting.” (*Note that the entire section is not included for purposes of brevity only.*)
20 Additionally, *Art. IV, § 4* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Bylaws will be
21 reformatted to conform with the existing indentations in this section.

22 **SECTION V.** *Art. V, § 1* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Bylaws shall be
23 amended as follows:

24 “Robert’s Rules of Order shall be the official source of information when questions occur
25 during the meeting except when it comes to conflict with the ~~by-laws~~ [bylaws]. The Speaker
26 of the House, after speaking with the Parliamentarian, shall have the power to designate an
27 official version of Robert’s Rules of Order to be used by the Senate.”

28 **SECTION VI.** *Art. VI, § 1* of the Wake Forest University Student Government Bylaws shall be
29 amended as follows:

30 “[Barring a two-thirds vote in the Senate,] ~~∆~~ [a] bill or resolution must be presented to
31 one of the Standing Committees for approval prior to its being introduced on the floor[.]
32 ~~∅~~ [Alternatively, a bill or resolution may] be introduced by an Executive Officer of the
33 Student Government ~~or the Chief of Staff~~ [and bypass a Standing Committee for
34 consideration by the Senate].”

35 **SECTION VII.** This bill shall take effect immediately upon passage.
