Summary:

Videographers are a part of the Student Marketing Team within the Wellbeing Center. Videographers work with the professional staff members of the Wake Forest Wellbeing Center (which include the departments of Campus Recreation, the Office of Wellbeing, and Student Health Services) to create videos of classes, workshops, and other events. The role of Videographer for the Student Marketing Team requires videography skills (see preferred knowledge, skills, abilities), motivation and drive to work independently and take initiative, and a professional demeanor while representing Campus Recreation while working.

Essential Functions:

- Provide quality videography and cohesively edited video projects to all individuals including faculty, staff and students
- Positively represent the Wellbeing Center and Wake Forest University
- Attend staff meetings and required trainings
- Coordinate videography scheduling with professional staff members
- Able to respond to emails in a timely manner
- Able to complete assigned tasks in a timely manner
- Able to meet at least three times per semester with the entire team and/or in an individual meeting with the Marketing Director
- Utilize various cloud-based software and programs for communication and content creation

- Proficiency in professional videography editing software (e.g., Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut ProX, Camtasia, etc.)
- DSLR/Video camera operation, photographic composition, video-editing

- Ability to collaborate and work independently
- Desire to take initiative in self-led projects
- Reliable, trustworthy and punctual
- Previous brand-related videography and/or marketing experience
