- Cleaning Supplies (i.e. Swiffer, Small Vacuum, Cleaning Wipes)
- Coffee Maker (Keurig/Single-Serving only)
- Dish Set
- First Aid Kit
- Memo Board for Door
- Posters/Room Decorations
- Raincoat/Umbrella
- Shower Shoes/Caddy
- Storage Bins/Closet Organizers
- Toiletries
- Towels/Washcloths
- Trash Can

#### Devices

- Alarm Clock
- Desk Lamp
- Flashlight
- Hair Dryer
- Small Fan
- Television (Streaming service available for use on TVs, laptops and mobile devices)
- UL-approved Power Strips (with a Circuit Breaker)

#### Laundry

- Clothes Hangers
- Detergent (HE Approved)
- Dryer Sheets/Fabric Softner
- Iron/Ironing Board
- Laundry Basket/Bag

#### Sleep

- Bedspread
- Blankets
- Pillow/Pillowcases
- Twin Sheets (XL)

#### Study

- Calendar
- Office Supplies (Pens/Pencils, Notebooks, Stapler, Folders)
- Stationary/Stamps

### Items To Leave At Home

- Air Conditioners
- Bed Lofts
- Black Lights
- Candles (Including decorative or warmers)
- Cinder Blocks
- Coil Appliances
- Crockpots, Waffle Iron and Crepe Pans
- Electric/George Foreman Grills
- Electric/Space Heaters
- Extension Cords
- Fans with Cooling Systems
- Fireworks/Weapons (including Paintball Guns)
- Flammables
- Foam Mattress Toppers
- Halogen Lamps
- Hot Plates/Electric Skillets
- Humidifiers/Misters (Including Diffusers)
- Microwaves
- Multi-Plug Adapters
- Non UL-Approved Lighting
- Pets and Animals (only exception are fish in 10 gal or less tank)
- Plug-In Air Fresheners
- Toasters/Toaster Ovens
- Waterbeds
- Wireless computer access points or network routers
