- Backpack

Devices

- Cell phone with charger
- Desk lamp
- Hair dryer
- Laptop with charger
- Small fan
- Television
- UL approved surge protector

Laundry Supplies

- Clothes hangers
- Dryer sheets
- Drying rack
- High efficiency detergent
- Laundry bag/basket
- Stain remover

Identification & Funds

- Credit card/debit card
- Driver's license, passport/visa
- Insurance info (health, renters)
- Social Security Card (needed for employment)

Miscellaneous

- Class/Desk supplies
- First aid kit
- Flashlight
- Umbrella/raingear
- Command strips/hooks

Things to leave behind

- Air conditioners
- Bed lofts
- Black lights
- Candles (including decorative or warmers)
- Coil appliances, grills, hot plates/electric skillet
- Electric/Space heaters
- Extension cords
- Flammables
- Halogen lamps
- Humidifiers/Misters (including Diffusers)
- Microwaves
- Multi-Plug adapters
- Unapproved pets and animals
- Plug-In Air Fresheners
- Toaster/Toaster ovens
- Toilet paper
- Wireless computer access points or network routers

Items below are not prohibited, but we suggest considering alternatives

- Decor that could be considered profane, obscene, offensive or indecent
- Foam mattress pads (consider breathable versions or ones with mold protection covers)
- Large furniture items (futons, couches, etc. ALL rooms are fully furnished)
- Nails, duct tape and other adhesives or hooks that may damage the walls or furniture
