

Virtual Call to Conversation Topics and Prompts

The C2C topic is the broader theme, and the prompt provides an entry point that allows participants to share a story about themselves. Take a look at our list of topics and prompts and select what resonates with you.

DIVERSITY & INCLUSION

Tell us about an organization or group that you feel is diverse and inclusive and why. What does an ideal, inclusive organization look like?

FRIENDSHIP IN A TIME OF SOCIAL DISTANCING

Friendship is one of the most important practices of community and character, but social distancing creates particular challenges for friendship. Describe one friend who has been especially important to you during this time and why that friendship has been so meaningful.

GROWTH

Tell us about an experience that took you out of your comfort zone and how you grew from it.

LIFELONG LEARNING

What is something you have learned, or are in the process of learning, that is stretching you? OR What websites, podcasts, readings, etc. have been informing your response to the world's current challenges?

THE POWER OF THE ARTS

What do the arts teach us about diversity and inclusion that we can apply elsewhere in our lives? OR Give an example of how the "Power of the Arts" has manifested in unique, creative and innovative ways in response to the COVID-19 crisis. OR Tell us about your most salient arts experience.

PRO HUMANITATE IN A POLARIZED SOCIETY

Tell us about a time either professionally or personally when you worked cooperatively with someone whose views were different from your own.

RESILIENCE & EMBRACING CHANGE

Share an example of something that has changed in your life or community as a result of the pandemic that you hope to see continue.

SHOW HUMANITATE

Show Humanitate has emerged as a catchphrase at Wake Forest that means *Pro Humanitate* in action and leading by example. Share an example of Show Humanitate in your community that you believe has served the greater good.
