Lovefeast Coffee Recipe

3 oz. dark, freshly roasted finely ground coffee 1 cup sugar 1 1/4 cups half-and-half 48 fl. oz. of water

Brew one pot of freshly roasted finely ground coffee. Add sugar and half-and-half. Stir to combine. Serves 10-12.

Lovefeast Candle Assembly Instructions

Materials: 1 candle, 1 pre-cut ribbon "skirt", 2 glue dots


1. Fold the pre-cut wribbon lengthwise, and hold one end ~1" up from the bottom of the candle.



3. Put one glue dot on the inner layer's edge of the ribbon, and glue it to to bottom of the candle. Repeat with the second layer, gluing both ends down.



2. Wrap the ribbon around the candle in a spiral going towards the bottom.



4. Fluff your loops (just stick your finger through them and separate the ribbon), and be transported by the magical lighting of the Lovefeast candles during the service!



Live Stream Step-By-Step Instructions

- 1. Make sure that your device is connected to the internet.
- 2. Open any web browser, and navigate to the following website: https:// lovefeast.wfu.edu/video/
- 3. Click the button that says "WATCH" if the stream has already started (30 minutes prior to service). You do NOT need to create an account to stream the video.
- 4. Prior to Sunday, you can test your connction by playing one of the Lovefeast service videos from years past. Make sure that both the video and the audio work. This will be the exact same interface that we will use Sunday, so if you can play those videos, you are all set!
- 5. Consider the audio for your gathering. If you will be streaming through a Smart TV or via a streaming device like Google Chromecast, you will play the sound through the TV's speakers. If you are using a projector and screen, and streaming through your computer, you will either want to connect to an external speaker (using bluetooth or an auxillary cord) or hook up to the room's A/V system if you are not hosting at a home.
- 6. Please take time to test your technology before the Lovefeast service on Sunday, so that we can troubleshoot and answer questions if needed! Please reach out to us with any questions (pg. 2)

Local Lovefeast **Pre-Gathering Checklist**

- □ Place Lovefeast buns in freezer when they arrive Saturday! Take them out 3-4 hours before your service (optional: place them in a basket to serve).
- □ Think through the "flow" of the evening. Will you serve the coffee and buns, or will it be self-serve? Consider designating someone as "lead" singer to help carry the group in singing. Or, during the carols, allow guests to mingle and gather their own bun and coffee.
- □ If you're hosting at venue other than a home, please consider hanging the provided signs to direct people to the correct room (there is a space to draw arrows).
- □ Make coffee (recipe on next page you'll need cream and sugar).
- □ Set out coffee, buns, mugs, and napkins or prepare them to be served.
- □ Set out nametags & marker, check-in sheet, programs, informational materials and candle supplies & instructions.
- □ Arrange chairs with view of screen.
- □ Connect to Livestream 10 minutes before service begins (https:// lovefeast.wfu.edu/video/) and make sure that your audio is connected, either through the TV or through an external speaker (your computer or phone speaker is likely not loud enough). More details about technology are on the back of the next page.

Local Lovefeast **Gathering Checklist**
