Two programs for elementary children or teens available to book now!

DISCOVER MOROCCO (PREK-5 OR TEEN)

Using images and objects from the Museum's collections, participants will learn about the mix of people, cultures, and arts that make Morocco such a fascinating country.

- *PreK through 5th grade children will create a stained glass paper lantern.*
- *Teens will make Moroccan-style tiles.*



Kites of Japan (PreK-5 or Teen)

Looking at images and objects from the Museum's collections, participants will explore Japanese culture and learn why kites are important to the Japanese people.

- *PreK through 5th grade children will make a simple Samurai kite.*
- *Teens will build and decorate larger kites inspired by Japanese traditions.*

The program fee is \$5.00 per child. There is no charge for adults.

For groups of 20 or fewer, there is a minimum fee of \$100.

This summer, there will be construction outside of the Museum, and we will not be able to host groups here. However, we are happy to come to your location! There is a small flat mileage fee based on your location associated with outreach programs. We will waive that fee for groups that have come to the Museum in the last two years.
