(a) In 2022, Alabama voters approved a new Alabama Constitution of 2022, to take effect Jan. 1, 2023. Also during 2022, Alabama voters in May approved 1 statewide amendment on the ballot and in November approved 10 statewide amendments and 17 of 19 local amendments, for a total of 11 statewide and 17 local amendments. Depending on how these are classified, the 2022 Constitution could be considered to have been
