This pass/fail option applies to any course in the school curriculum, but you <u>must obtain your professor's approval</u> . You must also notify the Registrar of your election to take a course pass/fail by completing this "PASS/FAIL FORM". Have your professor and the LL.M. Director sign this form and return it to the Registrar.
If you choose to write a thesis, you may elect to have it graded either numerically/letter grade or pass/fail You must inform your thesis advisor of this choice. You must also complete a "LLM THESIS OPTION (850) REGISTRATION AUTHORIZATION" form and return it to the Registrar.
Likewise, you may choose to write a seminar paper instead of a thesis. In this case, you must complete a "LLM SEMINAR PAPER OPTION (853) REGISTRATION AUTHORIZATION" form and return in to the Registrar.
All LL.M.s will receive a pass/fail grade on the Introduction to American Law course.
A student may not change from the pass/fail to the graded option or vice versa during the final two weeks of the semester.
