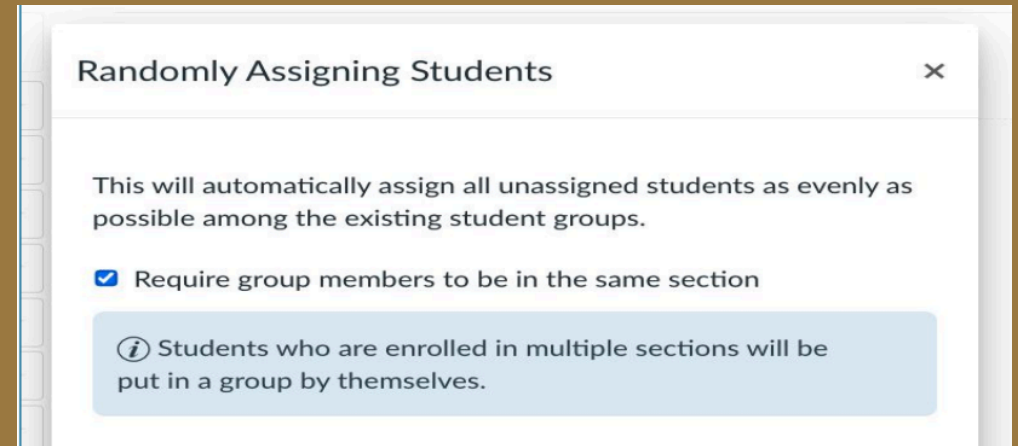

Summary: In the Groups page, when the Require group members to be in the same section checkbox is selected a tooltip displays.

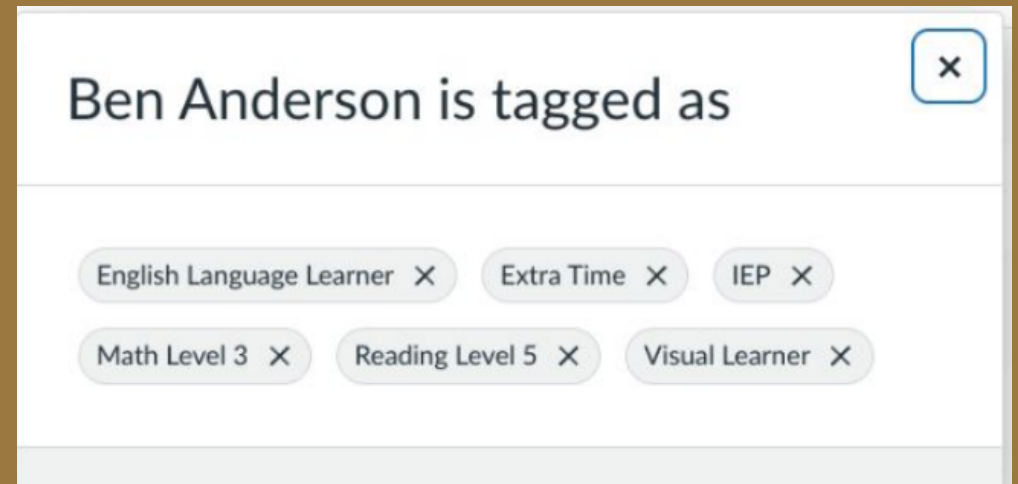
Change Benefit: In the Groups page, when the Require group members to be in the same section checkbox is selected



Tag Display Updated in Different Modal

Summary: The Differentiation Tag modal displays tags horizontally. When tags reach the modal's maximum width, they wrap to the next line. If the modal's height is exceeded, tags become scrollable.

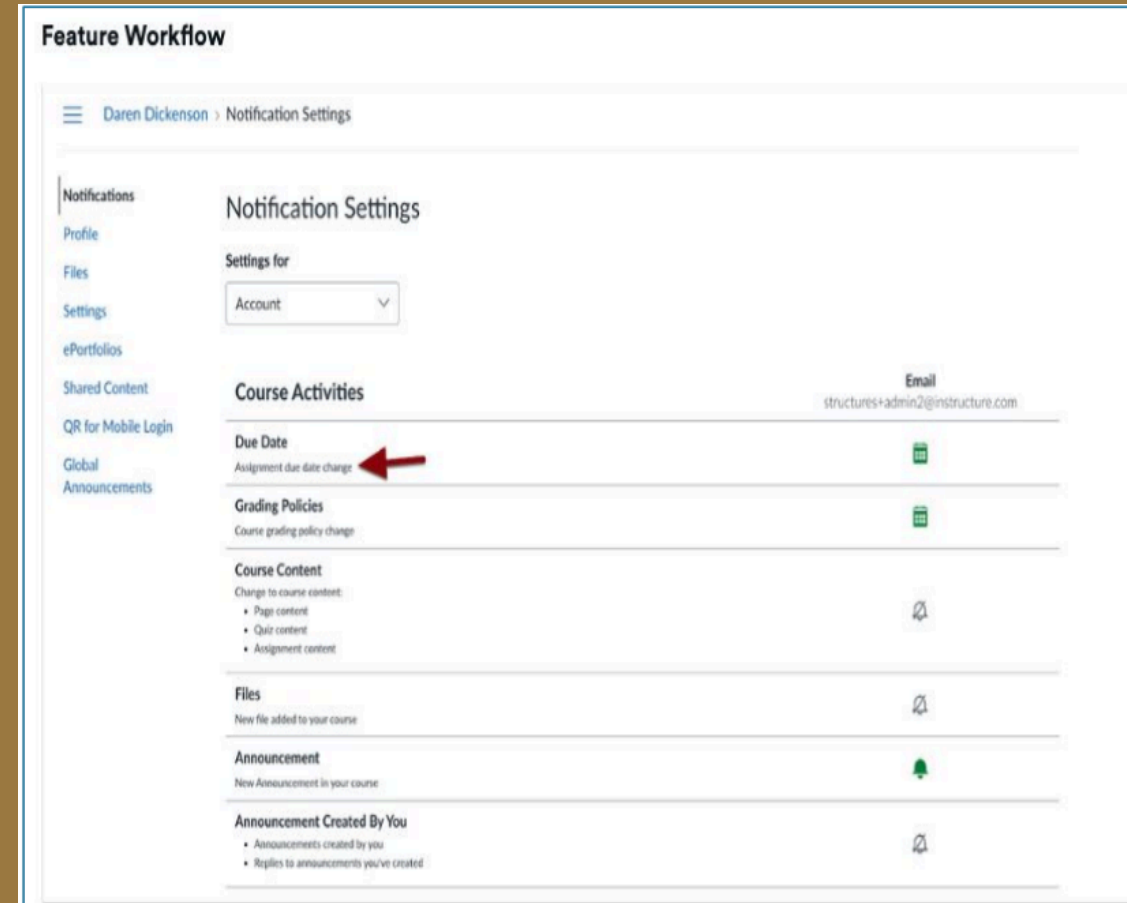
Change Benefit: This change streamlines the setup process, making it more efficient, particularly for courses with large enrollments or multiple sections.

Summary: The User Notifications page displays Course Activity definitions directly on the page, rather than as tooltips shown on hover.

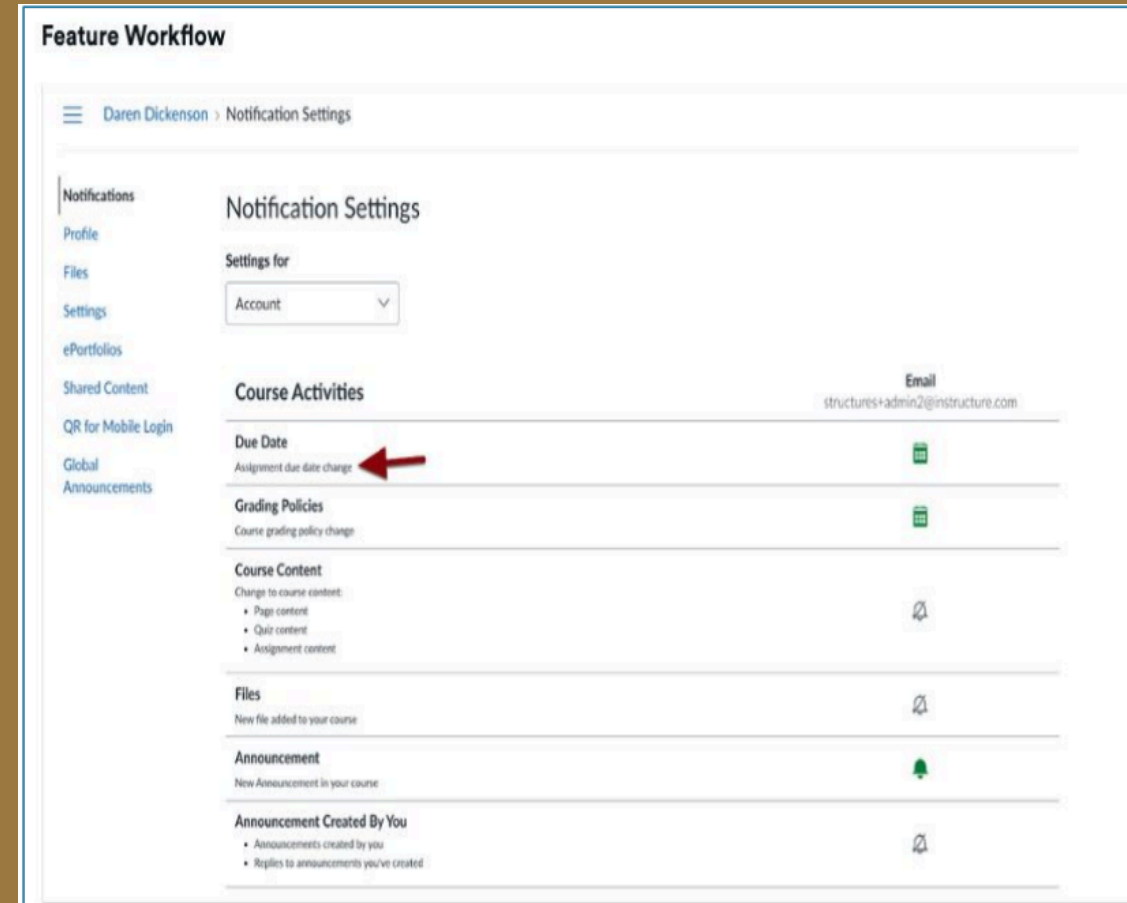

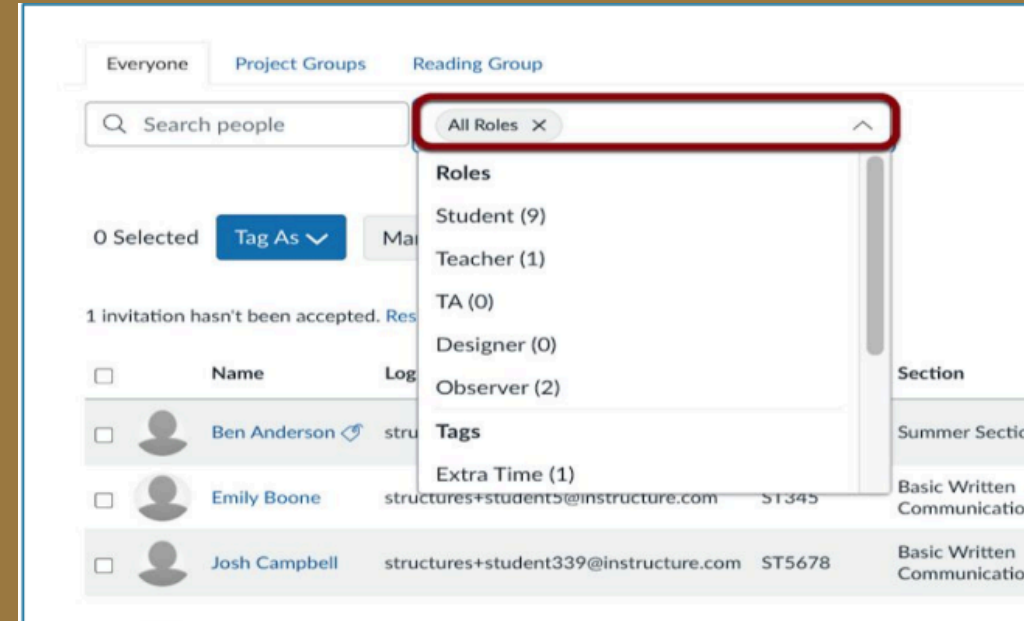
