

#### **Biography**

Felicia Goodrum earned her Ph.D. from the Wake Forest University Graduate School of Arts and Sciences studying cell cycle restrictions to adenovirus replication. Her faculty mentor was Dr. David A. Ornelles, Department of Microbiology/Immunology, Wake Forest School of Medicine. She trained as a postdoctoral fellow from 1998 until 1999 in the Microbiology/Immunology Department of Wake Forest School of Medicine, and at Princeton University in the laboratory of Dr. Thomas Shenk studying human cytomegalovirus latency from 1999 until 2006. She joined the faculty at the University of Arizona in 2006.

#### **Research Overview**

Our research focuses on the complex host-virus interactions that result in viral persistence. Progress in understanding latent programs of persistence have been impeded by the inherent complexity of the viruses and that paucity of adequate model systems. Herpesviruses are extraordinary for their ability to coexist with their host by establishing life-long latent infections. Latency is defined as a reversibly quiescent state during which viral gene expression and replication is highly restricted. Our laboratory studies cytomegalovirus or CMV, one of eight human herpesviruses.
