

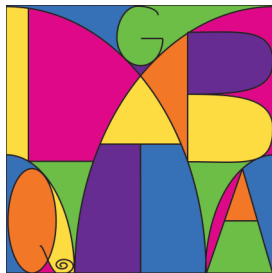
Keynote Speaker, J. Robby Gregg

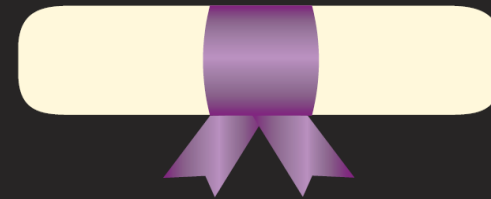
