



How to Enroll Online

Online enrollment is the fastest and easiest way to enroll. Before you enroll, have the following information available:

- Your Social Security number
- Your beneficiary's Social Security number, birth date and address
- Your investment allocations (learn more at www.tiaa-cref.org/wfu).

To Enroll online

Go to www.tiaa-cref.org/wfu, and click "Enroll Now." Next, click the plan name under the "Online Enrollment" section. You will come to the "Welcome" page. Once on this page:

- Enter your User ID and click "Log In" if you have an established TIAA-CREF User ID and Password. Click "Register with TIAA-CREF" if you are a first-time user and need to create your User ID and Password.
- Follow the on-screen directions to complete your enrollment application.
- Note: At the allocation screen, click on any investment choice to view its fact sheet.
- Next, print a confirmation page from the "Thank You" screen.


