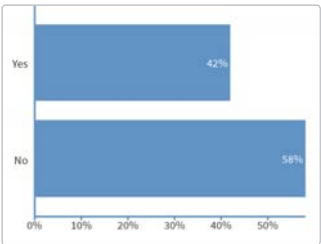

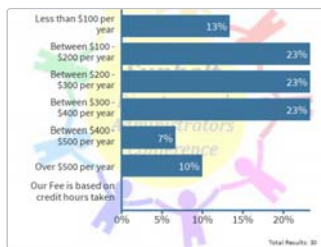

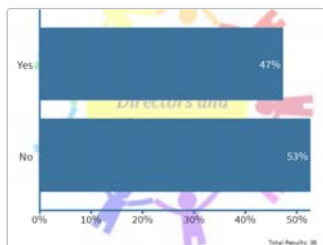

## Are you in network with any insurance companies?

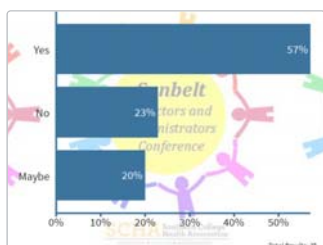

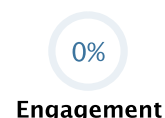

## Do you have mandatory insurance?

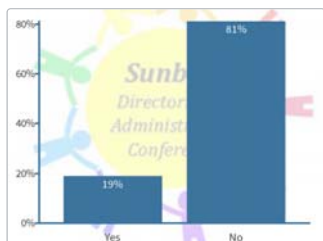

## Are you a Medicaid provider?

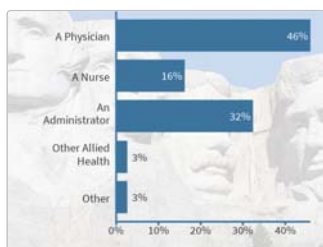

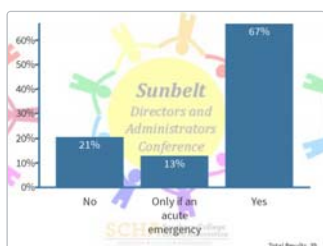

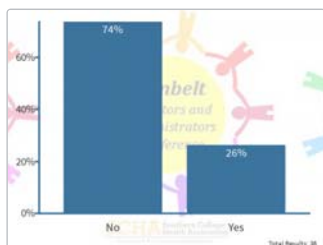

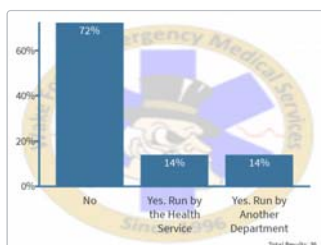

## Do you have an EMT First Responder Program on campus?

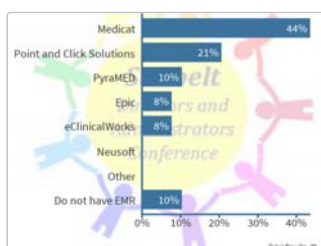

## What Electronic Medical Record do you use?

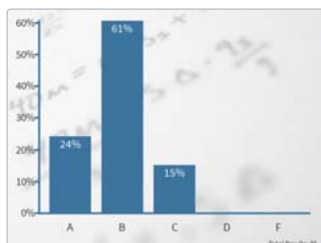

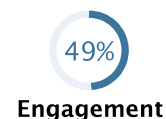

## How would you grade your EMR - overall score

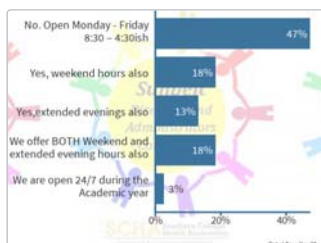

Does your clinic screen for depression during routine primary care visits?

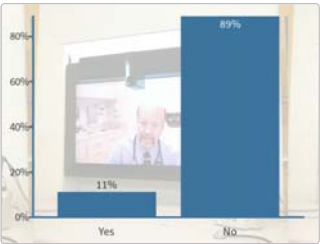

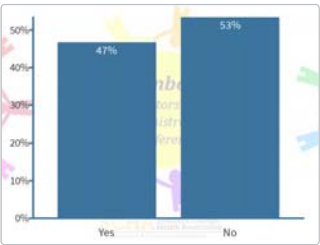
