# DAY 3: Montecatini - Pisa - Lucca - Montecatini



Following our first full Italian breakfast, we depart for Pisa, where we tour the Duomo, Baptistery and Cemetery. We have time to browse through the lively shopping stalls before departing for Lucca, a city whose Roman origins are still evident today in the grid pattern of its streets. Our guided tour highlights the eleventh-century Duomo, built in the Pisan Romanesque style; the church of San Michele in Foro, Piazza del Mercato, and views of the Torre dei Guinigi. We return to Montecatini and have dinner on our own this evening. (B) Hotel Adua or similar

#### DAY 4: Montecatini - Florence - Montecatini

After breakfast, we depart for the Renaissance city of **Florence**. Upon arrival, we enjoy a **guided walking tour**, which takes us to Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistery with Ghiberti's Gates of Paradise, and the Cathedral of St. Maria del Fiore. We have some free time to shop and enjoy the atmosphere of this dazzling city as we eat lunch on our own. We end our tour with a **visit to the Academy of Fine Arts** to view Michelangelo's *David*. This morning, we depart for Pienza, a Renaissance jewel created in 1458, specializing in Pecorino, a delicious cheese made exclusively from sheep milk. Here, we enjoy a tasting of local cheese before continuing to the quaint village of Montalcino. Upon arrival in this hill town, famous for its Brunello wine made with the Sangiovese Grosso grape, we have a wine tasting and guided visit to a local wine cellar. We have time to explore the city on our own before returning to Montecatini where we make dinner arrangements on our own. (B) Hotel Adua or similar

# DAY 7: Montecatini - San Gimignano - Siena - Montecatini

After breakfast this morning, we depart for the charming medieval town of San Gimignano, named after the Bishop of Modena. Once inside the city's ancient gates, we feel as though we have stepped back in time as we walk through cobblestoned streets and medieval structures. Later this afternoon, we continue to Siena and delight in a guided walking tour of this picturesque city, highlighting the church of San Domenico, Loggia della Mercanzia, Piazza del Campo, and the Palazzo Publico.
