Application Checklist

- 1. Application Form and Essays
- 2. Unofficial High School Transcript
- 3. English Proficiency. To demonstrate English proficiency, students need one of the following:
 - a. A grade of A or higher in their current English class, or
 - **b.** Minimum score of 90 on the TOEFL, 6.5 on the IELTS, or B on IGCSE English.
- 4. Academic Reference Form(s)
 - **a.** <u>If you do not submit a TOEFL or IELTS score, we require **two** academic references</u>: one from your English teacher and one from your Science teacher. Please print out two copies of the Academic Reference Form, fill in your name and birthday, and hand one to your English teacher and one to your Science teacher.
 - **b.** If you do submit a TOEFL or IELTS score, we require **one** academic reference. Print the Academic Reference Form, fill in your name and birthday, and hand the form to your Science teacher.

5. Application Fee

Please submit application Item 1 via online application (explorer.global.wfu.edu/apply)

If you prefer to submit a written application, please download the written application and scan your completed application and essays into PDF documents and email them to exploreradmissions@wfu.edu.

Please ask your college counselor to submit Items 2, 3, and 4 to exploreradmissions@wfu.edu.

Please make the payment of your Item 5 (application fee) of RMB 180 to your school's Finance Office with the comment "Explorer Application Fee: _Your Student's Name_".

Timeline

- The application deadline is February 22. The earlier you apply, the earlier your admissions decision is released.
- Applications are reviewed and notifications provided to students on a continuous basis.
- All students will be notified of their admissions decision before March 15.
- Accepted student deposits (US \$380) are due on March 28.
- Accepted student tuition remaining balance due on May 9.
