

## Notes:

- 1) Beginning with WFU 2011 data and National 2011, data are based on year of matriculation into medical school. Prior to 2011, the National data was based on year of matriculation and the WFU data was based on the year of graduation.
- 2) For the 2012 matriculation class, there were 110 Wake Forest students or graduates who applied to medical school, both allopathic and asteopathic. Of those 110, 57 matriculated into medical school which is a 52% matriculation rate. The North Carolina medical schools accepting students who matriculated into medical school in 2012 are as follows: The Brody School of Medicine of East Carolina University 5; University of North Carolina School of Medicine 2; Wake Forest University School of Medicine 10.
