Lounge and Block Housing Review and Renewal Process

- 1. All organizations occupying a leased lounge and/or block housing are subjected to a triennial spring review by the Committee on Student Life. This review covers the three-year period ending with the spring semester in which the review occurs.
- 2. Evaluation criteria include the following:
 - Group academic performance.
 - Group judicial history.
 - Facility care, safety, and maintenance.
 - Fiscal responsibility.
 - Contributions to the residence hall community.
 - Contributions to student development.
 - Contributions to the intellectual and cultural life of the campus.
 - Community service contributions.
 - Long-term organizational history and citizenship.
- 3. Information will be requested from the Office of Residence Life and Housing and the organization under review. Requested information will be received by the Committee on Student Life at a date to be determined in the spring semester; reviewing results will be distributed to the affected organizations in April, and appeals will be heard in late April, if needed, by the Committee or requested by the organization.
- 4. The Office of Residence Life and Housing is to submit information on:
 - Judicial history.
 - General student life contributions.
 - Residence hall contributions.
 - Facility care, safety, and maintenance (e.g., inspection summaries, damage and fine summaries, facility enhancements).
 - Fiscal responsibility.
 - Party management history.
 - Campus contributions.
 - Academic achievement and performance history.
- 5. The organization under review is to submit a report covering all criteria specified in Item 2 above.
