RESOLUTION

Resolved by the Senate of the Wake Forest University Student Government here assembled, That the following be proposed as an amendment to Article I, Section 2 the By-Laws of the Legislative Branch of the Wake Forest University Student Government, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes of the By-Laws when ratified by two-thirds of the Legislature:

“5. Parliamentarian: The student shall make certain that the Legislature’s by-laws are adhered to at all times and shall assist when needed in maintaining proper parliamentary law in legislative meetings. They shall further ensure that the governing documents are up to date after any alteration of said documents. The Parliamentarian shall review all pending legislation for grammatical errors and make such necessary adjustments in collaboration with the Speaker of the House. The position is appointed by the Speaker, is advisory, is allowed to speak at will, shall serve as a non-voting member of the Judiciary Committee, and is a non-voting member of the Legislature unless he/she is elected or appointed.”
