Guidelines for Service Animals in Training at WFU

Requirements

- 1. Follow the established and published processes for registering an Emotional Support Animal (ESA) or Service Animal through Residence Life & Housing.
- 2. Adhere to all policies and procedures described in the "Requirements and Agreement for Maintaining Service and Therapy Animals for Residential Students at Wake Forest University."
- 3. Provide an estimated amount of time the animal will be in training and let both LAC-DS and RL&H know when the animal is no longer on campus.
- 4. Animal must wear a collar and leash, harness or cape identifying the animal as a service animal in training.

Recommendations

- 1. Provide documentation from a service animal association regarding describing the commitment to training a service animal.
- 2. Provide periodic (no less than monthly) reports from the training agency regarding the service animal's progress in the training program.
